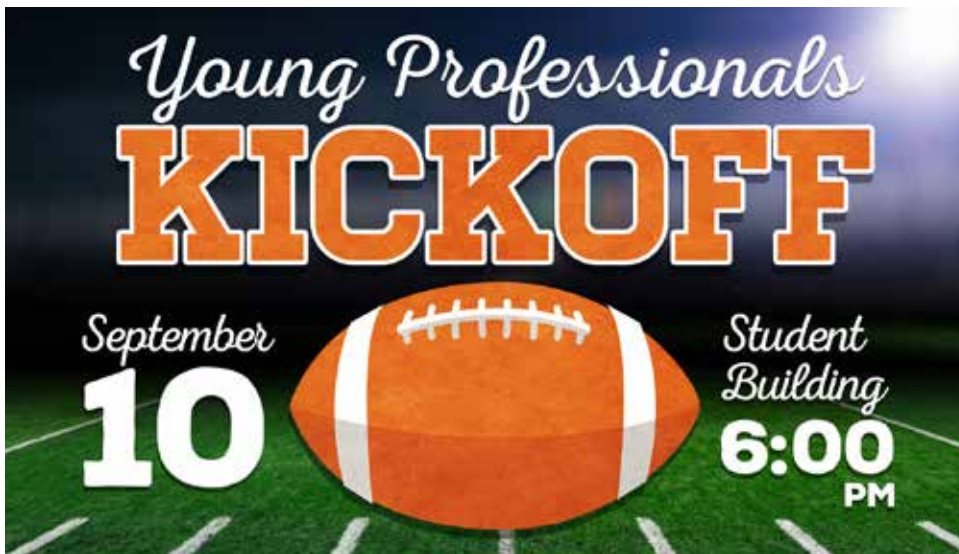

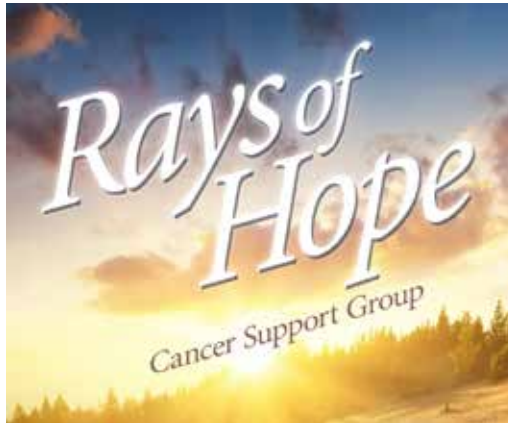
Drivers Needed
